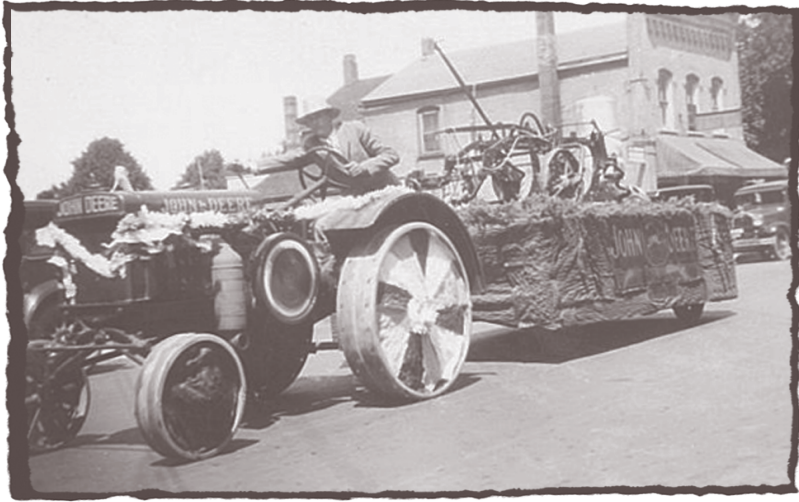

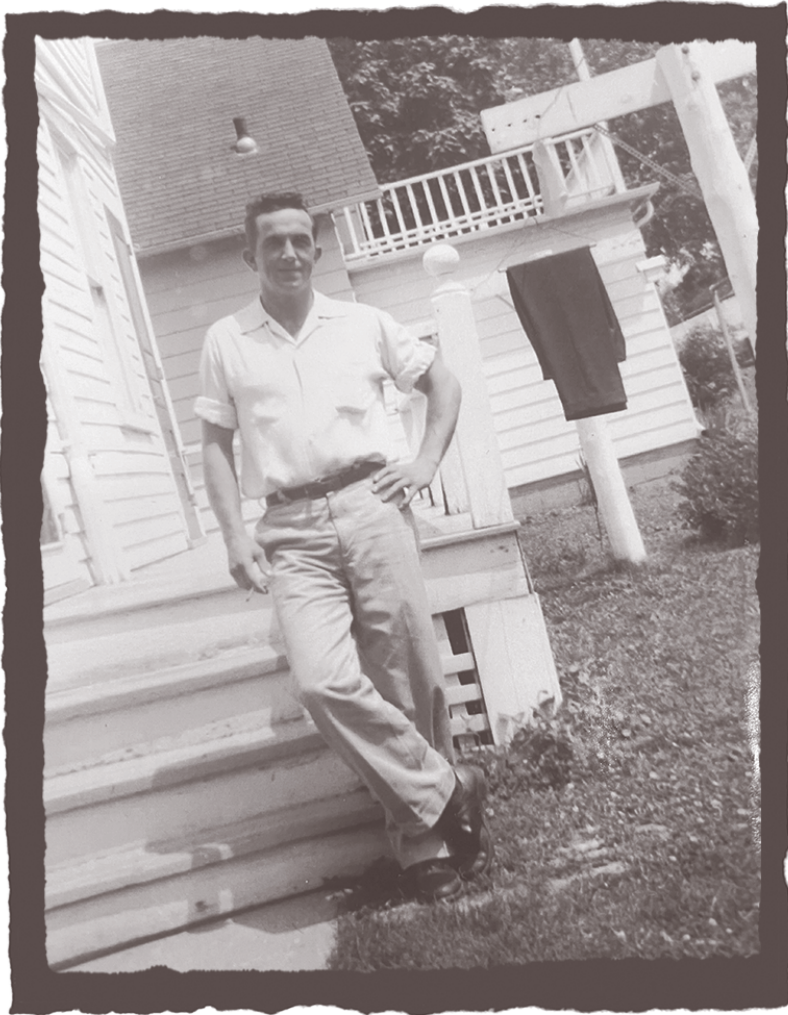
Early 1950's - Flowers at the Fair

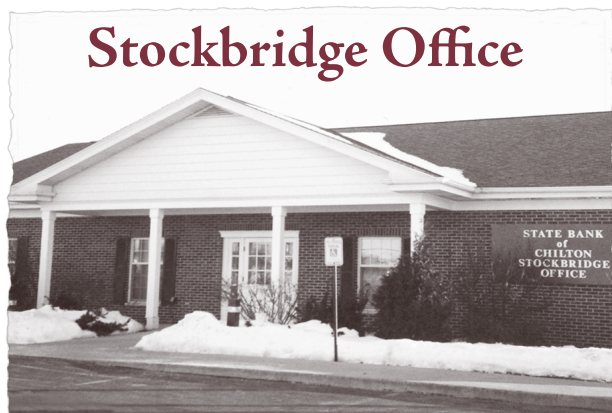
